MANDATORY INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACTS SUBMISSION

Posters only

Papers should be submitted in English, online, at www.admedic.pt

Submission deadline March 31, 2026

The presenter must be registered in the Course.

ABSTRACTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Introduction
- Goals
- Material and methods
- Results
- Discussion/Conclusions

When electronically submitting abstracts, they must be filled out all fields provided:

- TITLE: Must be in ALL CAPS (maximum 100 characters);
- TEXT: Limited to 2500 characters;
- INSTITUTION: Indicate the name of the Institution to which the authors are affiliated;

• AUTHORS NAME: The name of the person who will make the presentation must be indicated in the first place;

- The presenting author must be registered at the Course;
- Abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee;
- After abstracts evaluation by the relevant committee, authors will be notified by email, communicating the approval or exclusion of the abstract;
- Abstracts accepted as moderated electronic posters will be physically presented at the Course. Each presenter will give 3 minutes of highlights, using their electronic posters (no slides are permitted). Moderators will address questions at their discretion, either after each presentation or at the end of the session.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- The place of work should not be mentioned in the text of the summary;
- . When submitting the work, you must choose the status for it:

DRAFT You can make any changes you want until the submission deadline. The final version must be submitted by March 31, 2026. Please note that work in a draft state will not be considered for evaluation.

FINAL VERSION You cannot make any changes, the summary is ready to be evaluated.
